Open to any students going into 3rd through 8th grades.

Camp occurs from 1:00 – 3:15 PM, Monday through Friday, June 22nd – July 17th (no class on July 3rd & 4th) at Redwood Middle School.

Summer Music Classes



Summer Chorus:

This is a class *for students of any age who love to sing!* No previous singing experience is necessary. Students will learn the correct posture to produce a beautiful singing sound. They will learn how to properly use the voice so that it is not strained, the basics of sight-singing and how to read music. Students will also learn a variety of songs showing different periods and styles in music and will perform what they have learned in our "works in progress" performance on the last day of class.

Beginning Woodwinds, Brass, Strings & Percussion:

These classes are for students who would like to *learn to play a woodwind instrument (flute, oboe, clarinet, alto or tenor saxophone), a brass instrument (trumpet, trombone, baritone, French horn, tuba), a string instrument (violin, viola, cello, string bass), or a percussion instrument (snare drum, bass drum, cymbals, triangle, maracas and others).* Students will also learn the basics of reading music in these classes. The teacher will introduce and demonstrate each instrument during the first two days of class before students choose the instruments that will suit them best. Students will perform what they have learned at our "works in progress" performance on the last day of class.

Intermediate/Advanced Woodwinds, Brass, Strings & Percussion:

These classes are for students that have been playing for *at least a full year or more on their instruments.* Students will be grouped by ability level and will continue learning and playing music appropriate for their level. These classes help students gain more facility and confidence on their instruments.

Beginning Color Guard:

This class is for those students who would like to *learn how to twirl a flag and learn to march.* No previous experience is needed. On the first day of class, the teacher will demonstrate what students will be learning and inform the students what further materials they will need for class. Students will learn the basics of flag and marching techniques and will learn a simple routine which they will perform at our "works in progress" performance on the last day of class.

Intermediate/Advanced Color Guard:

This class is for those who have had *at least one full year or more of color guard training.* Students will learn more advanced work with the tall flags and possibly other equipment. Students will be grouped by ability level and will learn a routine to perform at our "works in progress" performance on the last day of class. This is great preparation for doing color guard work at the middle school and high school levels. The color guard is an important part of the marching band program.

Marching & Drill:

This is a wonderful class *for any student wanting to improve body and brain coordination.* Students will learn proper body posture, marching techniques, marching commands and routines. Students will be challenged to move up as many levels as they can during the span of the class with increasingly complex commands and routines.
