Chaperone Information

Chaperones are extremely important for the success of our Band and Color Guard! We really appreciate the fact that you are giving up your day to be sure our students are safe and well cared for before, during, and after each parade. Without your help we could not travel!

We will need parents to help load and unload the truck with all the uniforms and instruments. This needs to be done carefully and with much organization and cooperation.

Chaperones need to carry the following items in a small cooler and day-pack:

- a small squirt bottle with very cold water
- a strong plastic baggie with small ice chips
- a small bag of lemon drops (available at Long's)
- a few rubber bands, hair pins, bandages
- medium-size safety pins
- a small baggie with a damp washcloth
- a small hair brush and comb
- a pair of medium length white and black shoe laces

Chaperones should be dressed in dark long pants or jeans, and a white long or short-sleeved shirt.

Additionally, chaperones may be lent a black and white chaperone jacket on the morning of the event, OR you may bring a black or white jacket of your own. Please do not wear colored jackets and sweaters. We would like our chaperones to have somewhat of a uniform look as well! This helps our students better identify you when need be.
